Basic condition of admission

The basic condition for admission to the master's degree study (the second-degree study programme) is the full completion of the first degree of university study (Higher Education Act, No. 131/2002 Coll. as amended) in the same field of study or in a study programme (in the study programme Teaching of the English Language and Literature and Citizenship Education and in the study programme Mediamatics and Cultural Heritage) or in a study programme related in content to the study programme (in the study programme Mediamatics and Cultural Heritage). In the case of a foreign applicant or a student who completed his/her study abroad, he/she shall submit along with the application form (no later than the date of enrolment), a decision on the recognition of the certificate of completion of the first degree of higher education recognised by a relevant institution in the Slovak Republic.

Other conditions of admission

STUDY PROGRAMME - TEACHING OF THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE AND CITIZENSHIP EDUCATION

The condition for admission to the second degree of university study is the full completion of the first degree of university study in the same study programme. The graduates from the Faculty of Humanities UNIZA with a study average up to 1.75 will be admitted without entrance examination. Other applicants with a lower study average or applicants from other faculties and universities will take an entrance (colloquial) examination to verify their ability to complete the second degree of study. The examination will be in oral form in English and will consist of three parts: Debate about the final bachelor thesis, Linguistics, British and American culture and history and literature. In Citizenship Education the examination will consist of three parts: Debate about the final bachelor thesis, Didactics of citizenship education, Humanities and social sciences. The Department of English Language and Literature and the Department of Philosophy ensure the implementation of the entrance examination through an entrance examination committee appointed by the Dean of the Faculty. The fulfilment of the conditions for admission to study is evaluated by an admissions committee appointed by the Dean of the Faculty.

STUDY PROGRAMME - MEDIAMATICS AND CULTURAL HERITAGE

The condition for admission to the second degree of university study (master's degree) is the full completion of the first degree of university study in the same field of study or in a study programme whose content is related to the study programme Mediamatics and Cultural Heritage. The graduates of the bachelor's degree study programme Mediamatics and Cultural Heritage in the field of study Media and Communication Studies from the Faculty of Humanities UNIZA or more precisely the Faculty of Natural Sciences will be admitted without entrance exams. Graduates from other universities of the same field of study or a study programme whose content is related to the study programme Mediamatics and Cultural Heritage: the applicant will choose three books or articles from the proposed list of professional literature (the list will be published by the Department of Mediamatics and Cultural Heritage of the Faculty of Humanities UNIZA on the website) and will undergo an oral interview. The implementation of the entrance exam is provided by the Department of Mediamatics and Cultural Heritage of the Faculty of Humanities UNIZA. Fulfilment of the conditions for admission to study is assessed by the admission committee, which is appointed by the Dean of the Faculty.



ADMISSION OF FOREIGN STUDENTS

The basic and other terms and conditions of admission are applicable for applicants from abroad as well as for applicants from Slovakia.

Foreign students who study in the Slovak language do not have to pay the tuition fee. Applicants from the Czech Republic can use the form valid in the Czech Republic to submit the application for study. For foreign applicants who were accepted on the basis of intergovernmental agreements, bilateral agreements, or Slovak government grants, the terms and conditions stated in the respective documents are applicable.



APPLICATION FORM

Application forms are to be submitted for individual study programmes.

In case the applicant is interested in more study programmes, it is necessary to apply for each one individually, including payment of the respective admission procedure fees.

Applicants fill in the application form - Prihláška na vysokoškolské štúdium - 2. Stupeň or they can also use an electronic application form. The electronic application can be filled in via the UNIZA website: https://vzdelavanie.uniza.sk/prijimacky/index. php or on the Portal VS (University Portal): https:// prihlaskavs.sk/sk//. In the case of an electronic application, it is necessary to follow the instructions given in the E-application form System.

In case of an incomplete application form, applicants will be requested to complete it.

In case of non-participation in the admission procedure or a failure in the admission procedure, the Faculty does not refund the admission procedure fee. If the applicant wants to participate in the admission procedure at several faculties or UNIZA faculty programmes, the application forms must be submitted separately to each faculty and programme with the payment of the relevant fee.

The accommodation facilities of the University of Žilina provide accommodation according to the accommodation capacity, taking into account the distance between the student's permanent residence and the seat of the University. Accommodation fee: $\leq 41 - \leq 61 / month$.³

Students of all study programmes can obtain motivational scholarships (for excellent results or exceptional achievements) in accordance with the stated criteria. In case of an unfavourable social situation, the student can apply for a social scholarship during the study.

FOLLOW-UP STUDY AFTER COMPLETION OF MASTER'S DEGREE STUDY

There is a possibility of extended studies within follow-up doctoral degree study programmes at the Faculty of Humanities UNIZA in the academic year 2023/2024: Mediamatics and Cultural Heritage (information about study programmes can be found on the university website). After completing the master's degree, it is necessary to verify the current offer of the study programmes in a particular academic year.



MASTER'S DEGREE STUDY PROGRAMMES

MEDIAMATICS AND CULTURAL HERITAGE

(Field of study 7205 Media and Communication Studies)

Graduates have the ability to find modern and, if necessary, their own solutions in the field of media and communication practice. They are able to creatively apply knowledge, especially in the field of the creation of library and information collections, local and global information resources. They master the work with information and communication technologies, methods and tools for creating and building information resources, analysis of information needs, information retrieval, analysis of information resources and provision of information and knowledge to users. They are able to work as content creators or managers of mediamatics information systems, consultants in the field of information systems, creators of e-learning courses, and administrators of corporate information and knowledge bases. After graduation, they can independently run their own business in the field of mass media, provide information services for the state administration or the third sector, or work as specialists in the creation and presentation of information, economics, and management of mediamatics systems.

TEACHING OF THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE AND CITIZENSHIP EDUCATION

(Field of study 7605 Teaching and Pedagogical Sciences)

Graduates will acquire competences to work at primary schools, secondary schools, and higher education institutions as fully qualified teachers.
